REVIEW OLD BUSINESS

DISCUSS NEW BUSINESS

Coats: Karin at the Almart has received the spring catalog for kid's Carhartt inventory and she sent over the options. We have 3 options through Almart with a 15% discount on any Carhartt we buy through them. There is another coat that Kelly found at Big R and online made by Berne. We also have a few more style options that Laura has found such as winter coats and lined hoodies. We can now discuss the cost of the coats and the embroidery costs with Laura.

Sponsorship Program: In the short couple of weeks that we ran our sponsorship program we pulled together 5 sponsors! Since then we had some inquiries for more sponsors, including Vertical Property Services, Annie and Ophelia's parents, that would also like to have their logos on our banner as well. We have 2 options:

1. We tell these businesses that they need to wait until next year.
2. We do a one-two month push to find more sponsors. Revise the program to be a late add-on sponsorship with banner recognition ONLY (because the shirts are already printed) and then we reprint our banner since it was not that much of an expense.

Community Outreach Programs and Volunteering: We need to focus on a couple of volunteer projects for our club this year. Here are some options:

1. Delivering Valentine's Day Cards to the Seniors at the **Forest Ridge Senior Living Home in Woodland Park on February 14th, 2020 at 11:00am. Location: 16006 US-24 Woodland Park, CO 80863.** We will meet in the main lobby at 11am, where an activities coordinator will greet us and show us where to go to hand out the cards. There should be parking available anywhere up top [of the hospital] where you can find a spot.
2. Together We Rise: A company that sells - already put together - care packages, bags, birthday boxes and more for us to decorate and send to a foster care facility of our choosing. We have to pay for each program we pick to do, so we will need to do a fundraiser to reach our program goals. Each program contains about 10 bags, 10 boxes **OR** 10 care packages and they cost about \$200-\$300 per program. The company can set up an online fundraiser site (similar to a go-fund-me page) and we just have to share it with our friends, neighbors, community members and get them to donate. We can collect cash and checks to our club which we can then deposit and write a check to our fundraiser page. Once we have met or exceeded our goal then we order the programs that we want and they mail us the programs in about 2

weeks. Then we get to decorate the boxes, bags or whatever we chose. We could always bring the items to Burro days and allow people to help decorate the items with us as well? Then we send them to a foster care facility to be disbursed to the foster kids.

*Club Members now need to vote if they would like to do this program.

3. Help the Alma Foundation with community events like Bingo night or other events they put on like dinners and such. The club could offer to help bus tables, set up or clean up etc. -Kelly and Jolynn will get a schedule together with a list of jobs available to volunteer for.
4. Help the MRHI with events and things that they do for the community such as assisting with the preschooler hikes.
5. Help at the food bank. -Laura is working on getting a schedule for the volunteering times and jobs available.
