Cloverbuds-Ages 5-7. Activity based, no competition involved.

They are encouraged to participate in club events to prepare for full member status.

Junior-Ages 8-10 (must be 8 on or before December 31.) Some projects will combine the Intermediate age group into Juniors making the competing ages 8-13

Intermediate-Ages 11-13 (must be 11 on or before December 31)
Senior-Ages 14-18 (must be 14 on or before December 31)
Anyone turning 19 on or before December 31 will have aged out of the program and is encouraged

to continue on in the program as

a volunteer leader
